

St. Paul's Cheerleading Organization Parent Uniform Agreement

Uniforms are the property of St. Paul's School and its Cheerleading program. Uniforms are loaned to the students and are expected to be returned in good condition.

If your uniform is returned damaged, you will be responsible for the cost of the replacement. The cost for a new uniform is \$120. If payment is not made promptly to the SPS Cheerleading Organization, your child's report card will be held. This is treated as any other outstanding fees due to the school.

All uniforms will be collected at the end of the season. The uniform consists of a vest and skirt. Undergarments are yours to keep, but if you child out-grows the mid-riff and it is still in good condition, you may turn it in so that another child can use it. Your coach will establish the date and time for returns.

Uniform Care and Instructions:

Do not dry clean. Machine wash cold. No bleach. Tumble dry low. Touch up with a warm iron if needed.

Children must wear undergarments underneath their vest and skirt. Deodorant is needed for the middle-school age students to prevent perspiration and discoloration of the under arm area of the vest.

Please keep top half of agreement and return bottom half to your coach.
