

SAINT PAUL PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

- I will not force my child to participate in sports.
- I will inform the coaches of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child and/or others.
- I will become familiar with the rules of the game and support the officials.
- I will teach my child to play by the rules, remembering children learn by example.
- I will promote good sportsmanship, and show a respectful, positive attitude toward all participants.
- I will remember that the game is for children, not for adults.
- I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning. This will ensure that my child will never feel defeated and lose self-confidence in his/her performance for the outcome of the game.
- I will demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed or color.
- I will applaud good effort in both victory and defeat.
- I will remember that my child's coaches are volunteers, and I will support them.
- I will never argue with coaches, parents or spectators at a game.
- I will respect the official's judgment, and not question or argue.
- I will watch the game at a designated location, and cause no distraction to players, coaches or officials.
- I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free of foul language, drug and alcohol use, and I will refrain from their use at all sporting events.
- I will attend the Saint Paul preseason parent's meeting.

I also agree that if I fail to abide by this program's rules and guidelines, I will be subject to disciplinary action that could result in, but not limited to one of the following:

Verbal or written warning by league officials or Saint Paul School.

Parental and/or child game or season suspension by league officials.

Game forfeit.

Suspension may require parent and/or child to attend anger management counseling through a public or private source and provide proof of such.
