

St Paul's Cheerleading Behavior Agreement

The Administration and Coaching Staff of St. Paul School believe being a Cheerleader is a privilege; one that, along with being a great honor, carries with it many responsibilities. Each Cheerleader is a representative of St. Paul School and will conduct herself in an appropriate manner. St. Paul's Cheerleading is a school sponsored program and school rules apply.

The following criteria are expected of our Cheerleaders:

1. Our Cheerleaders are to conduct themselves as ladies at all times, and always show respect for their teachers, coaches, parents and for other students.
2. Our Cheerleaders are to display positive leadership at all times in our school.
3. Our Cheerleaders are to always strive for the highest in moral and spiritual values.
4. Our Cheerleaders will remember who they are, whom they are representing, and will conduct themselves accordingly.
5. Our Cheerleaders will arrive to all practices and sports events on time.
6. Cheerleaders will follow the directions given by the Coach or Authority figure.

Disrespect to Teacher or Coach

Any act of disrespect by a Cheerleader towards her teacher, coach, or member of the school administration will be handled swiftly. Punishment may include suspension or dismissal from Cheerleading for the remainder of the school year.

Facilities (gym, locker room, Storage room(s)).

1. Players are responsible for keeping the facilities in order and they should report any damages or problems to their coach or to the Athletic Director.
2. The school hallway and bathroom(s) are not to be used as a playground.
3. Only coaches and school staff are to be permitted in the storage room(s).
4. Coaches and team managers should inspect and pick up anything that is left in the gymnasium after games and/or practices.
